### Is it a bird song or bird call?

The distinction between bird songs and bird calls is based on inflection, length, and context. A bird song is longer and more complex, while a bird call is shorter and high-pitched. The bird song is associated with courtship and mating. The duration and quality of the song by the male bird indicates fitness. The ability of the male bird to hold and advertise his territory using song is another indicator of his fitness. Birds communicate through calls. Mobbing calls are used to call birds to an area where a predator may be present to scare it off. Bird calls also serve as a function to keep flocks in close contact. So the next time you hear loud, high-pitched bird calls, look for a cat!
